

SIUE Summer Exchange Program in Cuernavaca Mexico, Instituto Tecnológico de Monterrey

2011 Program Dates:

May 24 - arrival day
May 25 - 27 - Orientation, registration, campus tour, city tour
May 31 - classes begin
July 1 - classes end
July 4 - 6 final exams
July 8 - departure day



SIUE students pay SIUE tuition rates for courses taken at Monterrey Tech! Optional weekend excursions to various sites including Mexico City, Teotihuacan, Oaxaca, Ixtapa, and Taxco.

Course offerings include:

- Intensive Spanish Language course (beginning - advanced levels), Latin American Literature, Mexican Literature, Mexican Culture, Intermediate and advanced level composition courses and more.

Exchange Student Program Cost for 2011 summer program: \$1,680 (USD)

Includes registration fee, housing with a Mexican host family, 3 meals per day Monday - Saturday, airport pick up service, Cuernavaca city tour during orientation, extra-curricular activities including dancing, theater, painting, guitar, photography, and welcome and closing receptions. Payment of the program fee must be made in US dollars through a bank wire transfer.

Additional Costs to Consider:

- 3 - 6 hours SIUE tuition (no student fees) billed on SIUE summer 2011 bursar bill.
- Roundtrip airfare to Mexico City
- Optional excursions
- Sunday meals and personal spending.

Summer 2011 optional excursions:

Mexico City and Pyramids of Teotihuacan (3 days) \$190

Oaxaca (3 days) \$250

Ixtapa (3 days) \$260

Taxco (1 day) \$60

Excursion Package Total: \$760

Excursion price includes: bus transportation, tourist guide, hotel accommodations, entrance tickets to museums, tips, and staff person from International Programs Office who will accompany the group. Reservations and payment for the excursions must be made PRIOR to arrival. Payment deadline for excursions: April 22, 2011

Summer Application deadline: MARCH 1st.

\$100 activity fee and \$250 housing deposit must be paid by wire transfer upon submission of the application.

To Apply: Applications must be approved and submitted through SIUE's Office of Study Abroad.
