### EXCURSIONS:

The Office of International Programs organizes optional excursions to some of Mexico's most famous places during weekends. Commonly offered excursions include the pyramids of Xochicalco and Teotihuacan, Tepoztlan, Mexico City, Acapulco, Taxco (the silver town), and Puebla.

### HOUSING:

We suggest living with a Mexican family to get the full Mexican experience! This family-away-from-home will provide you with two daily meals in summer, clean rooms, and offer guidance, advice and whatever else you might need. They want to help you learn and feel part of the family. Additionally, most houses have a swimming pool.

### CAMPUS CUERNAVACA

The Tecnológico de Monterrey, Campus Cuernavaca is located just outside of the city of Cuernavaca, about a 20 minute ride from the downtown area. The new campus is close to the town of Xochitepec and next to the freeway leading to Acapulco, among other places.

With 2000 students per semester, the campus allows students to grow in their professional area while maintaining close contact with both students and faculty members. Furthermore, the campus has a steady international enrollment from universities around the globe, offering a fascinating multicultural environment for SIUE students to actively participate in campus life and Mexican society.



### CUERNAVACA

The colonial city of Cuernavaca was founded in the 12th century and is the capital of the state of Morelos. Its rich pre-Colombian heritage can be observed in archeological sites around the city. The city was home to two of Mexico's most important historical figures: Moctezuma, the Aztec Emperor, and later the Spanish conqueror Hernán Cortés. Cuernavaca's unique central location— it takes only one hour to get to Mexico City and less than four to get to the beaches of Acapulco— allows easy travel to beautiful places
