#### Summer 2008 Program at Salzburg College - AUSTRIA

##### The Program

The Summer Session at [Salzburg College](#) offers an introduction to various aspects of the Austrian and European culture. Most courses emphasize the special opportunities provided by the Salzburg setting. Field experience including visits to historical sites, to cultural and professional institutions and the attendance of musical events constitute an important part of the program.



##### Courses

Students will enroll in two courses and will earn 6-7 credit hours at SIUE. Choices of courses include: German Language Studies, Understanding Austria, Austrian Literature and Culture, The European Union, Music History, The Mozart Project and Music Performance.

##### Field Trips

A four day trip to Vienna, Austria's historical capital, will provide a broad range of experiences related to history, art, music, and modern life. In addition, a variety of local field trips constitute an integrated part of the academic program. There is also some time for independent travel on weekends.

##### Home-stay

To maximize the cultural environment, students live with Austrian families and include two meals per day. Lunches are served at Salzburg College.

**Program Fee: \$4,490—Includes tuition, full room and board, local excursions, social events, a 4-day trip to Vienna.**
