## Study Abroad in ITALY

Earn up to six SIUE credit hours while experiencing the brilliance of Italy. The travel study program offers first-hand experience and the study of history and culture in this country, where some have argued the birth of modern consciousness took place during the Renaissance. This three-week program will introduce you to the artwork, architecture, and history of Italy, through classroom lectures and on-site walking tours, museum visits, and excursions to places of historic interest. All undergraduate program participants will enroll in HIST 300 (Italian Society & Culture). Students may elect to also take HIST 410 (Independent Study) to earn an additional 3 credits hours. Interested students may enroll in Italian language or art courses at SRISA.

### Your study abroad experience will include:

- Lectures by Dr. Frick in Italian culture and history at the Santa Reparata International School of Art (SRISA) campus in the historic center of Florence.
- Additional opportunities to study language, art or develop independent projects.
- Daily outings around the city to see the art and architecture, including trips to the Uffizi, Michelangelo's David, Brunelleschi's Dome, the Palazzo Medici, Santa Croce, the Museum of Science, the Palazzo Pitti and Boboli Gardens and more.
- Additional excursions to other cities and sites such as Pisa, Siena, Arezzo, the hill town of Fiesole, and breath-taking Cinque Terre on the Italian Riviera.

**PROGRAM FEE:** \$3,675\*

Includes roundtrip airfare from St. Louis to Florence, 3 weeks student apartment housing in Florence, breakfast daily, museum card, day trip to Siena and various city trips in and around Florence.

**Additional Costs to Consider:** 3 – 6 hours SIUE tuition billed on summer 2010 bursar bill, optional excursion package to Arezzo, Pisa, and Cinque Terre (\$200), meals (estimate \$500), and spending money.
