



Our Concerto Competition Winners

Max Zvolensky, Intermediate Division

Max is a 9-year old 4th grader at Albert Cassens Elementary School in Glen Carbon, IL. He has been studying violin with Ms. Vera McCoy-Sulentic in the SIUE Suzuki Program since the fall of 2019. Max is a member of the SIUE Suzuki Tour Group, Edwardsville Youth Orchestra with SIUE Suzuki Program, and Alton Youth Symphony. He also plays cello with his school Orchestra. In the past three years, Max attended SIUE Suzuki String Development Camp, which was his favorite summer camp. Aside from music, Max enjoys solving Rubik's cubes, playing video games, board games, chess, and kickball.

Darian Hawkins, Advanced Division

Darian Hawkins (senior at OFallon Township High School) is the son of Darrin Hawkins and Sheila Mitchell-Hawkins of Fairview Heights, Illinois. He is a member of the National Honor Society, National Music Honor Society, OTHS Symphonic Winds, SIUE Suzuki Tour Group, SIUE Advanced Chamber Ensemble (concertmaster) and the Belleville Philharmonic Youth Orchestra (concertmaster). Darian currently studies the violin, clarinet, and piano. He began the SIUE Suzuki String Program at the age of 9 years old (studying Books 1-10 under the tutelage of Erika Lord-Castillo and Allison Woerner). He has received superior ratings in the Illinois High School Association (IHSA) Solo and Ensemble (2021-2023) with the violin and clarinet. He was selected for the Illinois Music Educators Association (ILMEA) All-District Senior Orchestra (2020-2023) and ILMEA All-State Orchestra (2021-2023). Darian participates annually in the Belleville Philharmonic Intergenerational Orchestra and the OTHS Music Pit. He also participated in the Edwardsville Symphony (2023) and the McKendree University's Clarinet Choir and Honors Clarinet Quartet (2023). Darian won first place in the John and Kay Kendall Concerto Competition Intermediate Division (2019) and first place in the Advanced Division (2023). He placed second in the 2023 Tuerck Concerto Competition. His mentors are Allison Woerner, Erika Lord-Castillo, Devon Kirsch, Dr. Melissa Gustafon-Hinds, Phillip Carter, Dana Koehn, Angelina McLaughlin-Heil, Christopher Gass, Dr. Leon Burke III, Gail Long, Sharon Voss and Blake Duncan. Darian enjoys reading fictional novels, creative writing, playing the flute and viola and listening to music. He will attend SIUE in the fall of 2024 to study music education. He aspires to become an educator, conductor, and Suzuki instructor.

The Ensembles

Advanced Chamber Ensemble (ACE), Edwardsville Youth Orchestra (EYO), Edwardsville String Ensemble (ESE), and Beginning Orchestra (of Awesomeness) (BOA) are string ensembles that rehearse weekly on Saturday mornings and perform music representing a variety of styles and genres. ACE is our most advanced orchestra, EYO consists of intermediate to advanced players, and ESE's players have a minimum of one year playing experience. Beginning Orchestra is our first reading orchestra and is the first orchestral experience for most of its members.

SIUE Violin Tour Group, Viola Camerata, and Cello Ensemble offer advanced string players an opportunity to perform in an ensemble whose main focus is excellence in performance and educational outreach. The groups have performed across the U.S., Sweden, England, Scotland, France, Austria, the Czech Republic, Italy, Spain, Ireland, Germany, Switzerland, Latvia, Lithuania, Estonia, and Poland.
