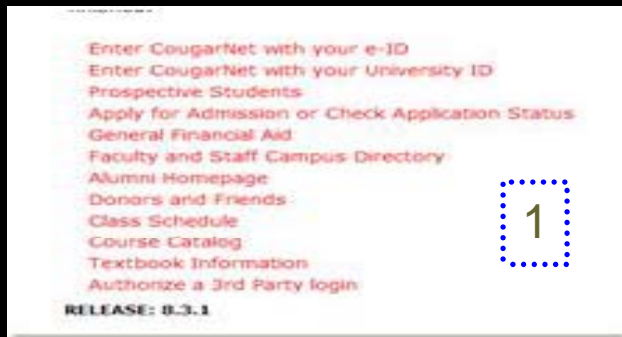

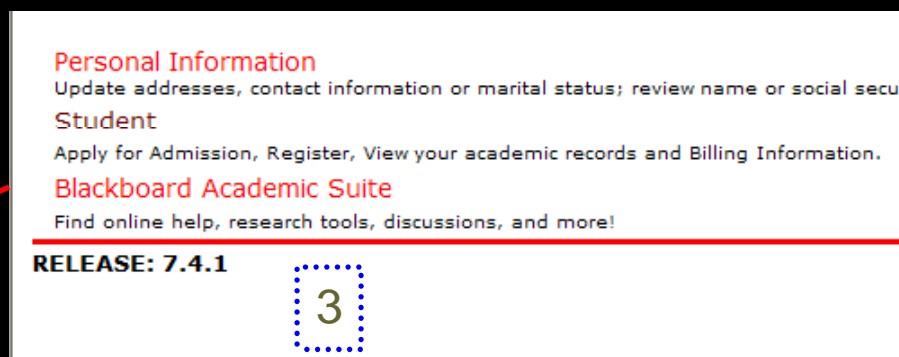

CougarNet

- If nothing is available, your transfer credit evaluation is in progress and not yet complete. Evaluations are not posted until credit from all institutions is evaluated.
- If your transfer credit is complete, you will see a semester by semester listing of all the courses you have transferred to SIUE. Your evaluation groups credit from each institution together, listed chronologically by semester.
- In order to ensure that records of all completed courses have been received and evaluated, review your evaluation to verify that credit from each institution is posted. Also confirm that credit for courses completed during your most recent term is posted.


CougarNet

- This record will not reflect hours in which you are currently enrolled, but should include all semesters completed to date.
- Once your evaluation is posted, all of the information is available to you and the advisor you will be meeting with: everything is now in place for you to see an advisor to discuss your academic plans for your first semester at SIUE. Complications arise if you attempt to schedule your advising appointment before your evaluation is complete. To avoid being held to requirements you may have already met, ensure that your evaluation is complete before advisement.
