

Workshop Description:

Morning session: Morning session: 9:00 am -11:30 am

Many school districts in Illinois have iPads or Chrome books, using iPads and students have iPhones so how do art teachers incorporate technology into the art classroom using these mobile devices. Students and Teachers will learn about current approaches to using this technology in the K-12 art room. Technology using iPads, Chrome books, and teaching iPhone photography with various Apps to computer-based lessons using Photoshop. Creating student and teacher videos to create community and discuss art themes with the general school population will be shared. Enduring Understandings, contemporary artists, and choosing the right App for your grade level, will be discussed. Attendees will receive a variety of resources including lesson examples, technology resources and examples of student work.

Audiences will learn about being an artist while teaching and traveling sketchbooks. Traveling sketchbooks are a great way for students and teachers to develop or supplement an artistic practice while sharing artwork and ideas with each other. Resources will be shared so that teachers can implement some of the ideas.

Afternoon session: Afternoon session: 1:00 pm - 3:30 pm

During the afternoon students and teachers will have a chance to practice one of the technology ideas talked about in the morning lecture. Students will work in teams to create a video and how to assign team jobs will be taught so that everyone has a clear role. They will create a Stop Motion video using a stop motion App (Stop Animator or HD Motion) and learn how to drop it into a green screen App (Do Ink Green Screen) and add a background and music. Materials used will include an iPad, trifold green screen boards, and jointed mannequins. Copyright issues will be discussed and how to use open materials for this project.
