# SIUE CONCERTO/ARIA COMPETITION 2023-2024 AUDITIONS: TUESDAY 13 FEBRUARY 2024

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

All the following requirements must be met:

- a) You are seeking an undergraduate or graduate degree at SIUE (any major), Teacher Certification in music, or a Post-Baccalaureate Certificate in Piano or Voice Pedagogy.
- b) You are taking private lessons for university credit during the Spring 2024 semester
- c) You are participating in at least one major ensemble during the Spring 2024 semester

You may enter on more than one instrument, though no-one will be awarded more than one concert appearance. Certain pairs are not allowed, e.g., violin/viola, pairs within the same woodwind family (e.g., flute/piccolo, etc.). Each entry requires a separate application, and all eligibility rules apply for each application. Works for multiple instruments/voices may also be acceptable. Previous winners, except those from 2022-2023, are eligible.

#### REPERTOIRE

Your choice must fall into one of the categories below. Vocal pieces should be performed in the original language.

- a) One movement of a concerto or song cycle. In general, movements that have no "ending", i.e., where the ending is a transition into the following movement, will not be accepted by themselves. Such movements should be paired with the subsequent movement. In other words, you would need to qualify under c), below.
- b) A complete concerto or song cycle that is less than 10 minutes long.
- c) A sequence of movements or a complete concerto or song cycle that is more than 10 minutes long and that cannot be broken up
- d) A concert/opera/oratorio aria
- e) An unstaged operatic ensemble

Works need not be performed from memory. You must perform with an accompanist.

### **WINNERS**

Up to two winners will be chosen, though the judges reserve the right to award no prizes. The judges' decisions are final. Winners will perform with the University Orchestra on Friday 26 April 2024. Winners will perform the repertoire with which they entered

## **DEADLINES/AUDITION SCHEDULE**

1) Your repertoire selection must be approved by Dr. Mishra before your application will be accepted. Teachers are encouraged to send a list of repertoire to be approved that covers everyone in their studio who is entering. However, should this not happen, you are still responsible for obtaining approval. You must obtain approval before submitting the application form.

If you are doing a 20th or 21st century piece, which, due to copyright, almost always requires the rental of parts, please provide the name of publisher. This will help speed up the approval process.

- 2) Completed and signed applications must be returned to Dr. Mishra by **Monday 5 February 2024.** Applications received after this date will not be accepted.
- 3) Auditions will be held in Dunham Hall Theatre on **Tuesday 13 February 2024.** The schedule will be e-mailed to competitors a few days prior to the auditions.
