Before the arrival of Provost Ansari, there was discussion about a possible procedural problem with the CAS faculty survey and what steps to take in order to remedy it.

Provost Ansari:

- --understands that salary and budget issues are top concerns in CAS
- --believes in collaborative work on the budget
- --believes in being proactive
- --reiterated that Deans and departments made the decisions regarding how the 3.2% budget cut was handled last spring
- --proclaimed that he was against across-the-board cuts
- --has asked Deans, in collaboration with the units, to set strategic goals for each department
- --was not clear, since this occurred before his arrival, as to how campus input was assessed in the formulation of the New Reality project
- --believes strongly in undergraduate research
- --believes strongly in hands-on education and experiential learning
- --reiterated that in previous jobs he was entirely collaborative
- --conducted walk-throughs of buildings and departments
- -- announced that enrollment is strong for Winter term
- --declared that, at present, he has no plans to change summer faculty compensation
- --encouraged us to schedule appointments with him to discuss whatever is on our minds

Provost Ansari departed at 2:15 pm

- --The Leadership Council discussed how best to insure the fair and transparent operation of the College P&T Committee, especially under the new Bylaws.
- --There was discussion of whether and when to hold a CAS Congress meet-and-greet with CAS faculty.
