- Proof of Health Insurance: End of October
- Copy of passport: End of October
- Passport Photograph: End of October
- Travel Itinerary: Beginning of January
- Orientation Period: End of January (about a week before semester begins)
- Start of Program: End of January
- End of Program: End of May

Key Dates and Deadlines for Fall Semester

- Application Form Exchange Program: Beginning of May
- Copy of passport: Beginning of May
- Passport Photograph: Beginning of May
- Travel Itinerary: Mid-August
- Orientation Period: Beginning of September (about a week before semester begins)
- Start of Program: Mid-September
- End of Program: Mid-December

- 1. Apply for passport after admission letter has been sent from school at Circuit Court Clerk at 155 North Main Street Suite 120, Edwardsville, IL: Need Valid Drivers License, \$97 Check or Cash, and passport photo (Available at CVS across from Madison County Courthouse).
