## Illinois Manufacturing Facts

Manufacturers in Illinois account for 12.54% of the total output in the state, employing 9.58% of the workforce. Total output from manufacturing was \$108.43 billion in 2018. In addition, there were an average of 592,000 manufacturing employees in Illinois in 2019, with an average annual compensation of \$89,853.35 in 2018.

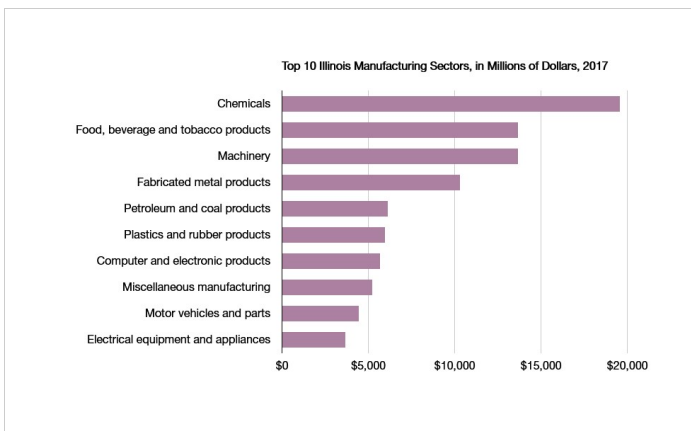
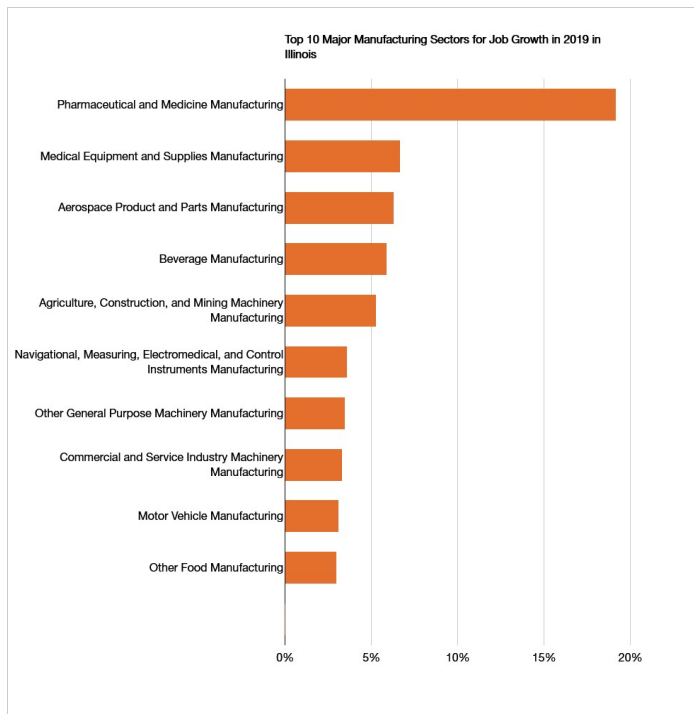
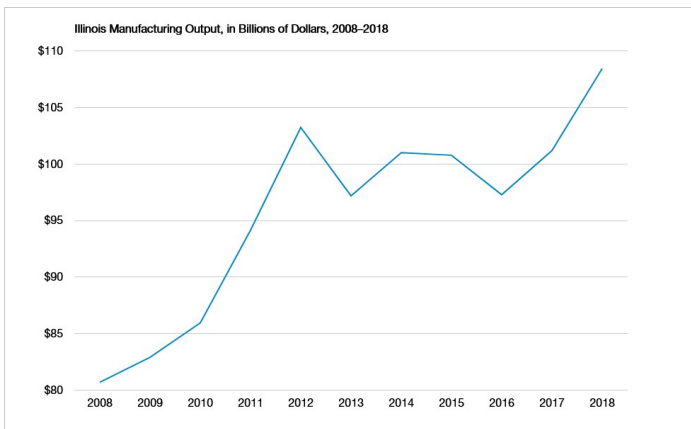

## Illinois Export Facts

Manufacturers help to drive Illinois's economy, with \$56.17 billion in manufactured goods exports in 2019. That same year, \$36.87 billion in exports was with our free trade agreement (FTA) partners. This helps create jobs in the state, and 26.90% of its employment stemmed from exports in 2011. Small businesses comprised 90.00% percent of all exporters in Illinois.

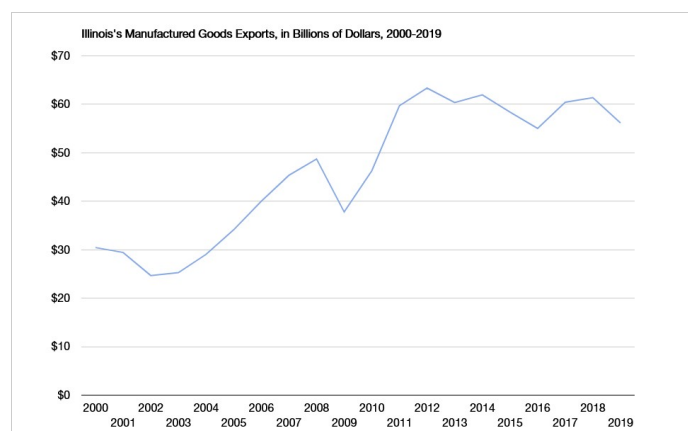

- The 20 U.S. FTA partners purchased 48.3% (\$659.49 billion) of U.S. manufactured goods exports in 2019 – even though these countries represent only six percent of the world's population and 10 percent of GDP.
- FTA countries: Australia, Bahrain, Canada, Chile, Colombia, Costa Rica, Dominican Republic, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, Israel, Jordan, Mexico, Morocco, Nicaragua, Oman, Panama, Peru, Singapore and South Korea.
