Please join the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity, Office of Trade & Investment on a multi-sector trade mission to Nairobi, Kenya and Dar es Salaam, Tanzania from March 27 to April 5, 2023.

The AmCham Business Summit will anchor the first leg of the mission. It will bring together American and East African business executives, investors, senior government officials and multilateral stakeholders to dialogue, showcase, and leverage opportunities for increased two-way trade and investment between the U.S., Kenya, and the East African region. Kenya is the most developed economy and one of the main ports in the East Africa region.

Then the delegation will fly down to Dar es Salaam for two days of structured business to business meetings. Dar es Salaam is the largest city and economic heartbeat of Tanzania, and main sea port for many Eastern and Central African countries with numerous business opportunities for Illinois companies. Tanzania is an attractive market for U.S. exporters due to its relatively large population estimated to be 62 million people. This makes Tanzania the 24th largest country in the world by population, larger than South Africa.

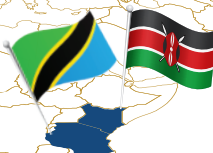
