Creating an Elevator Speech

An elevator speech or 30-second commercial is HOW you communicate WHO you are and WHY you are interesting. It answers the question, "Tell me about yourself?" and gives a brief introduction of you!

When writing an elevator speech, you should include the following information:

- 1. WHO am I?
- 2. WHAT is my objective? (career, networking, gaining information, etc.)
- 3. What is my PASSION?
- 4. What are my SKILLS (experience)?
- 5. What are my STRENGTHS?
- 6. WHAT do I want? (Internship request, job inquiry, networking, etc.)
