Each party should keep a copy of this agreement and make every effort to fulfill the terms of the agreement.

PROFESSIONAL CONDUCT

- By volunteering to participate as a mentee in the SIUE Mentoring Program, I understand that it is my responsibility to demonstrate professional conduct and behavior at all times. I will communicate and present myself professionally in all of my communications/interactions (in person, by phone, in writing, online).
- Lunderstand as an SIUE student, that I will refrain from consuming alcohol during all mentoring outings and activities. Mentoring meetings should be conducted in a place of business or in a public setting.
- I will be respectful and timely in all of my correspondence. I will acknowledge calls, emails and messages within a 48 hour timeframe.
- I will follow through and attend all scheduled meeting with my mentor. If a meeting needs to be rescheduled, I will provide 2 business days' notice if possible.

CONFIDENTIALITY

- I understand that my mentor may share personal information. I accept the responsibility to hold this information as confidential and private.
- I understand that failure to comply with these guidelines may result in termination of the mentoring relationship.
- I will not share my mentor's contact information with anyone else.
