

Southern Illinois University

Southern Illinois University is a multicampus university comprised of two institutions, Southern Illinois University Carbondale (SIUC), with a School of Medicine at Springfield, and Southern Illinois University Edwardsville (SIUE), with a School of Dental Medicine at Alton and a center in East St. Louis. The University, with an annual operating budget of over \$795 million, enrolls over 34,000 students in programs from two-year technical curricula to Ph.D. programs in a variety of fields and degrees in law and medicine, as well as first professional degrees in dental medicine and pharmacy. SIU was chartered in 1869 as Southern Illinois Normal University, a teachers' college. In 1947, the name was changed to Southern Illinois University, reflecting the institution's academic expansion. The University also expanded geographically. As early as 1949, SIU began offering courses in the metropolitan East St. Louis area, which led to the development of Southern Illinois University Edwardsville.

A modern and comprehensive post-secondary educational institution, Southern Illinois University

offers a broad range of academic programs leading to associate, baccalaureate, master's, specialist's, doctoral, and professional degrees.

The instructional, scholarship, and service missions of the two constituent institutions reflect the needs of the geographic areas in which they are located. The University also is committed to serving statewide, national, and international needs. This commitment is reflected in educational activities located off the main campuses in communities throughout the state. It is realized also through research and training exchanges and through worldwide student exchange programs.

A nine-member Board of Trustees governs Southern Illinois University and sets policy that enables the University to carry out its established missions and goals. The President of Southern Illinois University is its chief executive officer and reports to the Board of Trustees. The University Chancellors report directly to the President and are responsible for the internal operations of SIUE and SIUC, respectively.

Southern Illinois University Edwardsville

Southern Illinois University Edwardsville traces its origin to a recommendation made in 1956 by the Southwest Illinois Council for Higher Education. The Council was convinced that higher education facilities were needed in the Metro-East part of the greater St. Louis area. They hired consultants whose reports documented that need, and they appealed to Southern Illinois University, one hundred miles south, to establish satellite campuses.

In 1957, SIU opened two "residence centers" in Alton and East St. Louis. The University expected to enroll 800 students, but actual enrollment reached 1,776. By 1959, the number of students had more than doubled to 3,800, greatly exceeding the physical facilities and demanding services faster than the University could develop and supply them.

A planning team investigated sites in the Metro-East counties and selected one just south of Edwardsville. In 1960, the Illinois legislature authorized a bond issue for construction of a new state university campus. Voter approval came in November 1960. After two and one-half years of planning, University officials and area residents attended ground-breaking ceremonies for the first permanent buildings.

In the fall of 1965, Southern Illinois University Edwardsville moved onto its new campus just 25 miles from St. Louis—2,660 acres of rolling land and woods dotted with lakes along bluffs flanking the Mississippi River. Much of the land still retains its natural shape. The academic center was designed by the internationally known architectural firm of Hellmuth, Obata, and Kassabaum of St. Louis. The brick, slate, and granite of the modern buildings complement the terrain and are softened by a carefully designed garden landscape that attracts visitors by its physical beauty.

The campus has received several awards in recognition of the successful blend of the aesthetic and functional in a setting that enhances growth and development and is now featured among the top 150 Illinois Great Places by the American Institute of Architects Illinois Council.

Emphasizing teaching, research, and public service programs, Southern Illinois University Edwardsville is a fully accredited, premier Metropolitan university with nearly 14,000 students enrolled. SIUE is listed in the Best Colleges of 2010 issue of U.S.News & World Report as one of 77 schools nationwide, and among the top five in the Midwest recognized for its innovative changes as an "up-and-coming school firmly focused on improving the job they're doing today." For the fifth year U.S.News & World Report has heralded SIUE for its Senior Assignment Program, an integrative learning experience required of all seniors prior to graduation. SIUE is now listed among the Top 15 public master's level universities in the Midwest-Master's Category for the fourth consecutive year and is ranked by U.S. News in the top one-third of all public and private master's level universities in the Midwest. The University awards degrees in 44 baccalaureate and 69 master's programs encompassing the arts and sciences, nursing, education, business, and engineering. The Schools of Dental Medicine and Pharmacy award the D.M.D. and Pharm. D., respectively. The main campus also includes University Park, a research park established for economic development. The Edwardsville campus is supplemented by campuses in East St. Louis and Alton.

At SIUE, students find comprehensive educational opportunities and a community in which individuals support each other in their search for knowledge and individual development. SIUE's mission, vision, values and statement on diversity follow.

Honorary Degree Doctor of Humane Letters

Ralph F. Korte

Ralph F. Korte served as Chairman of the Board of the Korte Company, until his retirement in November 2008. He launched the company in 1958 and subsequently enrolled at SIUE. A strong supporter of higher education, Korte pursued his degree as a non-traditional student on nights and weekends through the SIUE School of Business, graduating with a bachelor of science in 1968.

Mr. Korte has been involved in the creation and implementation of a number of new initiatives on the SIUE campus. Guided by his passion for learning and helping others, Korte was instrumental in promoting the idea for the Department of Construction Management within the SIUE School of Engineering, which was developed in the fall of 1979.

Subsequent projects included the construction of the Ralph Korte Stadium in 1993; the donation of the Ralph and Donna Korte Classroom in the School of Business; the creation of the Ralph & Donna Korte Fund for Leadership and Innovation in Business Education in 1999; and the launch of the SIUE Construction Leadership Institute in 2004.

In November 2008, the Korte Company established the Ralph Korte Endowment Scholarship for students entering the Construction Management Program at SIUE. Individually and through corporate giving, Ralph Korte has donated nearly \$2 million over the course of 34 years. Currently, he remains active in The Gardens at SIUE as a Founding Friend and has

contributed both monetarily and as a volunteer assisting in the development of The Gardens project.

Throughout his career, he has held leadership positions on a variety of boards, including president of the Southern Illinois Builders Association, chairman of the SIUE Foundation Board, chairman of the SIUE School of Business Advisory Board, and chairman of the National Associated General Contractors (AGC) Education Committee. Additionally, Mr. Korte's professional activities have included serving as a Founding Member of the Illinois Business Roundtable, Southwestern Illinois Leadership Council and the Regional Business Council, as well as Emeritus Trustee of the Missouri Botanical Garden.

He has also received numerous awards including the Ernst & Young Entrepreneur of the Year Award, Salute to Southwestern Illinois Award, and the Silver Beaver Award (1983) and Silver Antelope Award (1989) from the Boy Scouts of America.

Korte is a lifetime member of the SIUE Alumni Association and continues to serve on the SIUE Foundation Board. He is a member of the inaugural class (2008) of the SIUE Alumni Hall of Fame.

Perhaps most notable, Ralph Korte is the first SIUE Commencement honoree to receive the Honorary Degree (2010), the Distinguished Service Award (1988), and the Distinguished Alumni Award (1978).

Charles 7. "Chuck" Tosovsky

Charles J. "Chuck" Tosovsky has been a dedicated business owner and active community participant for decades. He serves as president of Home Nursery, Inc., an award winning leader in producing field and container grown nursery stock and roses. Founded in 1921, the company continues to be a family owned and operated business, serving a 12-state territory. He is past president of the Edwardsville YMCA, the Edwardsville Jaycees, the Madison & St. Clair Nursery Association, the Edwardsville/Glen Carbon Chamber of Commerce, the Illinois Green Industry Association, the Edwardsville Zoning Board of Appeals, and the International Plant Propagators' Society Eastern Region. From 1986 to 1990, Mr. Tosovsky served as Governor of the Illinois chapter of the American Nursery and Landscape Association. He is past president and a current member of the Edwardsville Rotary Club, and a sustaining member of the Greater Edwardsville Area Community Foundation, donating toward various funds and scholarships in support of local initiatives.

Mr. Tosovsky has been recognized for his service within the horticultural industry as well as in the region. In 1993, he won the International Plant Propagators' Society Eastern Region Award of Merit. The award recognizes significant contributions in the field of plant propagation via scientific discovery, the application of facts to the propagation of plants, development of new practices or techniques, services rendered to the science and practice of plant propagation, or extraordinary service to the Society. Chuck also received the Edwardsville/Glen Carbon

Chamber of Commerce Albert Cassens Award for Community Achievement in 2007 for his work with The Gardens at SIUE. The award honors individuals who generously give of their time toward improving the quality of life in their community - he worked diligently for several years to bring world-class gardens to southwestern Illinois. Mr. Tosovsky's contributions are also future-oriented, as exemplified by the April 2008 establishment of the Chuck & Jean Tosovsky Family Fund for the Horticultural Research Institute (HRI) in support of research and special projects that will perpetuate the horticultural industry for future generations.

Mr. Tosovsky is a strong proponent of higher education and has contributed a great deal of time and support to SIUE for over thirty years. He has been a member of the Foundation Board of Directors since 1977, serving as President from 1995-1997, and is currently a Senior Director. Mr. Tosovsky is a member of the Benefactors' Society (2005-2006), helping to raise substantial private funding for the establishment of the Myer Arboretum and offering major philanthropic support for the 2009 Lantern project at The Gardens. He is a member of the Friends of The Gardens at SIUE and has donated more than 1,000 plants for the beautification of the facility. Chuck has also established funding for landscaping around Birger Hall, which houses the SIUE Foundation offices, and sponsored design and landscaping of the building's terrace which is used for various Foundation events.

History of Academic Regalia

The pageantry of the academic procession is used for many of the formal and significant events at Southern Illinois University Edwardsville.

Inherited from the medieval universities of the 11th and 12th centuries when woolen gowns and hoods were worn by scholars for warmth in unheated quarters, the wearing of academic vestments and the procession were not adopted throughout the United States until the late 19th century.

Academic life in the Middle Ages began first in the Church, then in the guilds. The teaching guild was the guild of the Master of Arts, where the Bachelor was the apprentice of the Master and the dress was the outward sign of privilege and responsibility, designed to distinguish the wearer from the merchants and other townsmen.

Principal features of academic dress are the gown, cap, and hood. Both Cambridge and Oxford Universities, since the 15th century, have made academic dress a matter of university control, even to its minor details, and have repeatedly published revised regulations. American universities agreed on a definite system in 1894. In 1932, the American Council on Education presented a revised code which, for the most part, governs the style of academic dress today.

The cap worn almost universally in academic processions is the Oxford cap, better known as the mortarboard. From poetry we learn that the cap of scholarship was square to symbolize a book. A different style, called the Cambridge cap, resembles a large beret.

The use of a dark hood in academic processions is thought to have arisen from the clerical practice of wearing a cap or mantle in religious processions during the 12th and 13th centuries, when universities arose from cathedral schools. Traditionally, gowns are also black. In recent years, however, a number of universities have adopted other hues which signify the school's traditional colors, such as crimson for Harvard, blue for Yale, purple for Northwestern, orange "hash marks" for Princeton, maize with azure blue chevron for the University of Michigan, maroon for the University of Chicago, and cardinal and gold for the University of Southern California. The bachelor's gown is a yoked, closed-front garment with long, pointed sleeves. The master's has long, closed sleeves slit just above the elbow, permitting the forearms to protrude. The doctor's has full, bell-shaped sleeves and is trimmed with velvet panels down the front, and three velvet bars on each sleeve. The color of the panels and sleeves varies to indicate the doctoral field.

The academic hoods, worn around the neck and down the back of the gown, are lined with the official colors of the college or university conferring the degree. The binding or edging of the hood usually represents the subject of the degree as follows:

Banners In the academic procession, each college and school within the University is represented by a commencement banner displaying its appropriate colors. The heraldic symbolism employed in the banners is broadly representative of the academic departments or disciplines within the college or school. For example, the banner for the College of Arts and Sciences displays a triangle with the colors white, brown, yellow, and cream to represent the humanities, fine arts, sciences, and social sciences, respectively. The triangle symbolizes the classic trivium of rhetoric, logic, and grammar.

SIUE's commencement banners were designed originally by William Van Nimwigen, a graphic designer with the Chicago Public Library System. The current banners were designed by the University's Marketing and Communications department.

Mace The SIUE Ceremonial Mace was created in 1981 by Michael E. Mason, retiree and former curator of The University Museum, who holds both a Bachelor of Arts and a Master of Fine Arts from this institution. At that time, the President of SIUE (the position now called Chancellor) Earl Lazerson decided that we needed traditional, formal regalia to use on significant ceremonial occasions. In 2005 Chancellor Vaughn Vandegrift restored the tradition of the Mace at all Commencement and other academic ceremonies. A stand was subsequently constructed and, in recognition of the values of the University, engraved brass plaques were added to the Ceremonial Mace with the words Citizenship, Excellence, Integrity, Openness, and Wisdom.
