- 4. No more than 5 non-program classes remaining
  - a. Non-Program courses include all the courses listed on Page 1
  - b. It is highly recommended to start the program with only two non-program courses remaining. Summer courses may be required if starting the program with more courses.
- 5. Completion of 42 semester hours
- 6. Earn a "C" or higher in PSYC 201
