- Produce content-delivery products as audio podcasts or video lectures.

#### **Design and Development of Online Courses (IT568) [June 1 – July 2, 2021]**

- Create a course syllabus that is effective within the context of an online classroom.
- Design and produce online lessons and modules using online instructional strategies.
- Consider innovative teaching in the online classroom, including the use of games, role plays, problem-solving activities, and simulations as anchors for your designs.
- Articulate a plan for evaluation of lessons/units/courses.

#### **Managing and Facilitating the Online Classroom (IT569) [July 5 – August 6, 2021]**

- Create efficient and effective day-to-day operations for online classrooms.
- Understand how to facilitate collaboration and interaction in the online classroom.
- Humanize the online classroom.
- Develop techniques for providing useful feedback to students in the online classroom.
