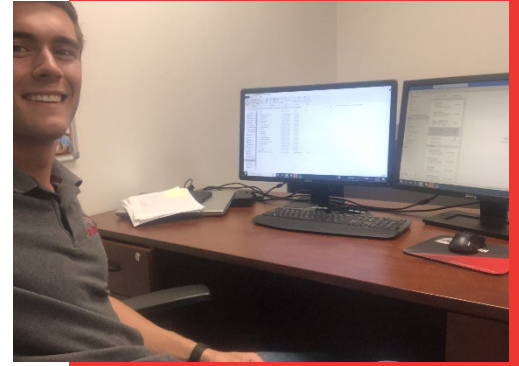

MAIN DUTIES

Prepares and maintains project plans, staffing requirements, and budgets. Performs administrative tasks such as preparing progress reports and arranging meetings. Communicates with clients, and tracks project progress.
