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# Academic Standing

- ▶ Pharmacy
  - ▶ Reviewed by School of Pharmacy
    - ▶ UR, Under Review
    - ▶ PP, School of Pharmacy Probation
    - ▶ PD, School of Pharmacy Dismissal
- ▶ Graduate
  - ▶ Retention is reviewed by Graduate Records and Academic Programs
    - ▶ Minimum 3.0 Cumulative GPA (Grade Point Average)
- ▶ Undergraduate
  - ▶ Good Standing
  - ▶ Warning
  - ▶ Probation
  - ▶ Suspension



# University Policy 111

- ▶ Academic Warning, Probation and Suspension, Undergraduate
  - ▶ Policy change approved in January 2018, effective Fall 2018
  - ▶ Addition of Warning
  - ▶ Removal from major
  - ▶ Return of first suspension students



# Office of the Registrar Procedures

- ▶ Academic Standing is updated at the conclusion of each fall, spring and summer term
- ▶ Review Suspended students
  - ▶ Unmarked repeats
  - ▶ GPA neutral term
- ▶ Manually update standing as appropriate
- ▶ Drop future term enrollment for suspended students as appropriate
- ▶ Notify all students whose academic standing changed at the end of the term

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# Good Standing

- ▶ All Undergraduate Students with a cumulative grade point average (GPA) at or above 2.0 are in good standing
  - ▶ Regardless of term GPA
  - ▶ Regardless of completion rates



# Warning

- ▶ Undergraduate students are placed on Warning when their cumulative GPA falls below 2.0
- ▶ They will remain on Warning until
  - ▶ The cumulative GPA is returned to a minimum of 2.0
  - ▶ Their **term** GPA falls below a 2.0

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# Probation

- ▶ Undergraduate students are placed on Probation if they fail to maintain a 2.0 **term** GPA while on Warning
- ▶ They will remain on Probation until
  - ▶ They achieve a minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA
  - ▶ Their term GPA falls below 2.0

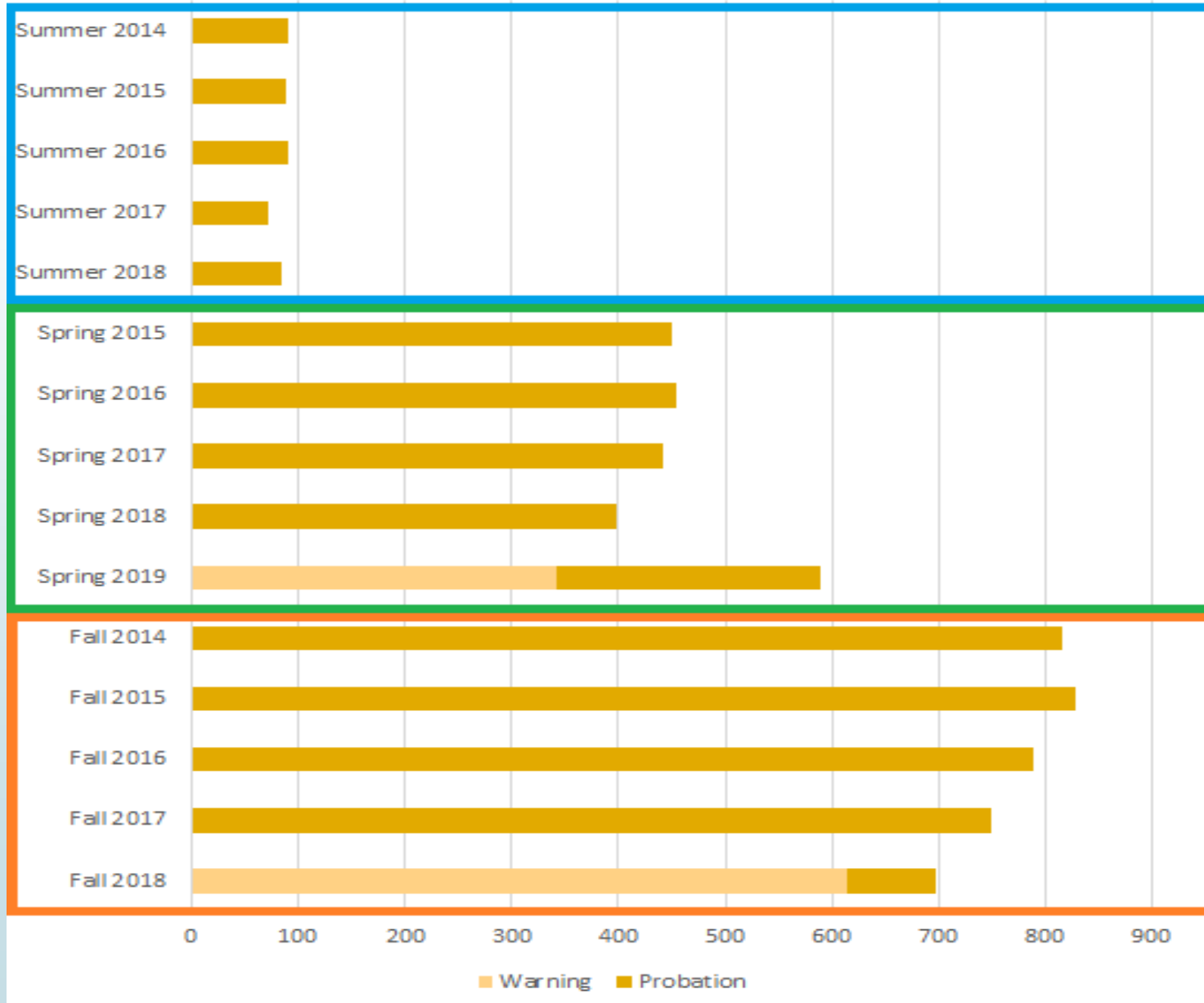


# Suspension

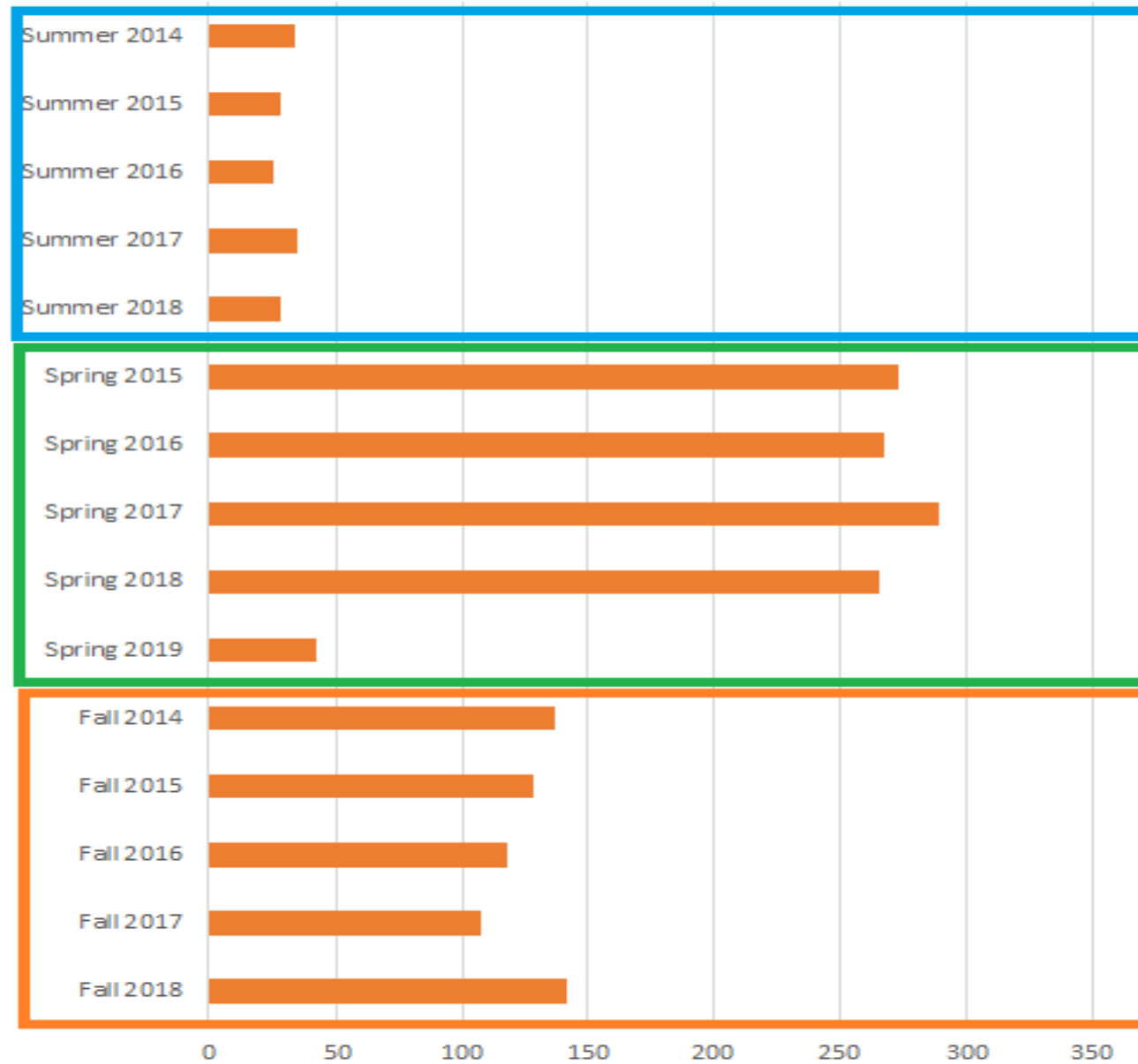
- ▶ Undergraduate students are placed on Suspension if their term GPA falls below 2.0 while they are on Probation
- ▶ First Suspension
  - ▶ Students may continue enrollment after sitting out one semester
- ▶ Second Suspension
  - ▶ Students may only return to the University after successful appeal to the Suspension Appeals Committee
- ▶ Third Suspension
  - ▶ Students are not permitted to return to the University

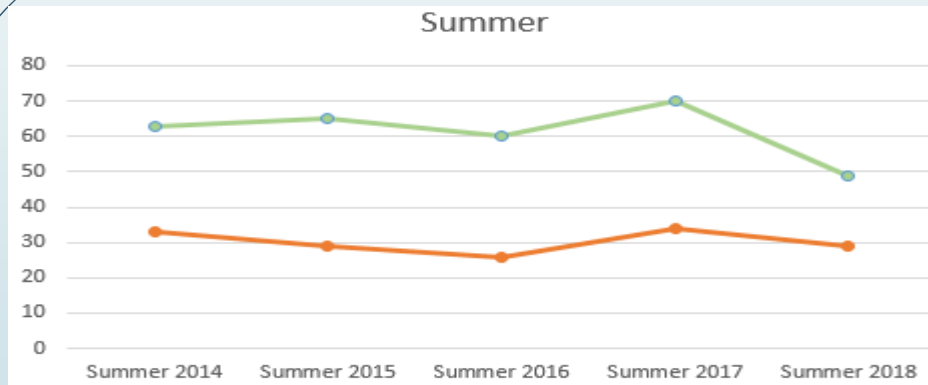
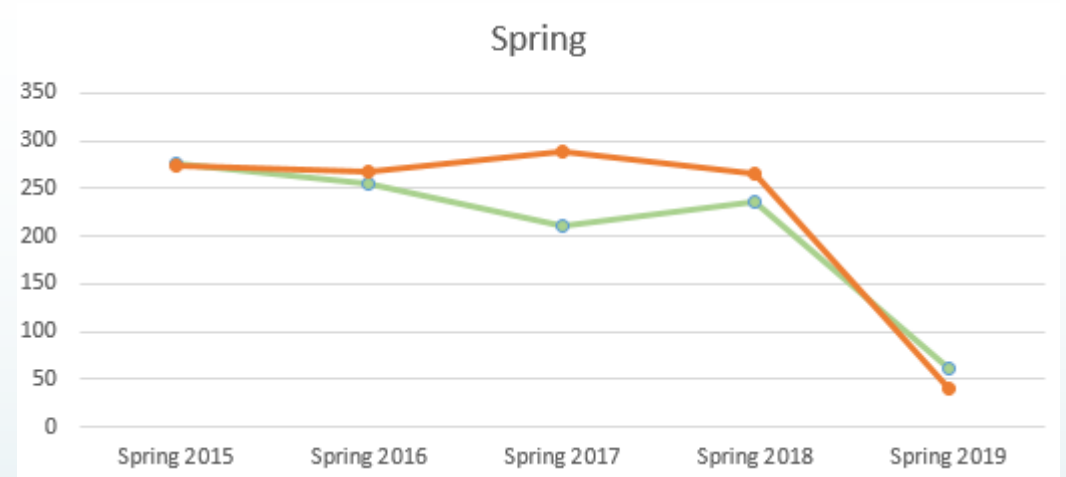
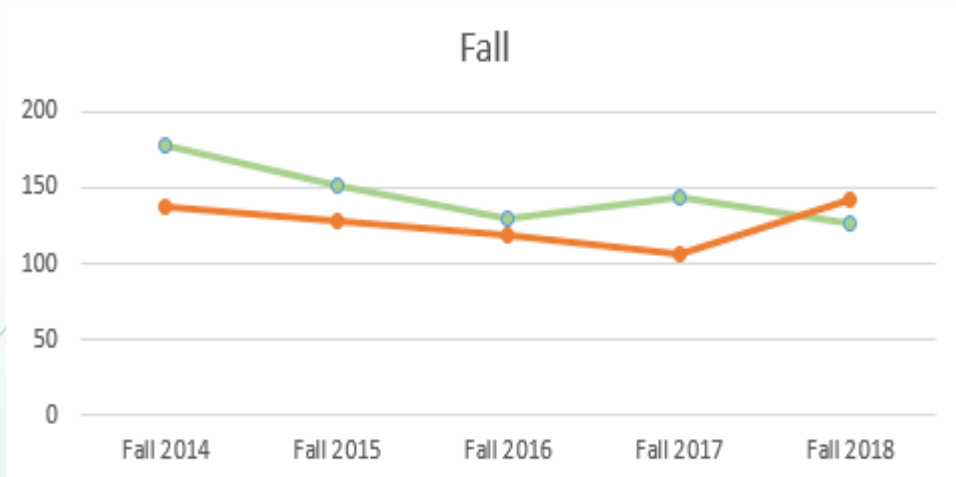


## Warning/Probation

# Spring 2019 Suspensions

- ▶ 47 Students were automatically placed on Suspension
  - ▶ 5 were removed based on GPA neutral enrollment
  - ▶ 1 removed following a previously unmarked repeat
- ▶ 16 First Suspension
- ▶ 23 Second Suspension
- ▶ 2 Third Suspension
- ▶ 7 Dropped from Summer term – 2 in May Session
- ▶ 4 Dropped from Fall
- ▶ 2 Retained in Fall

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# Summary

- ▶ Students should maintain a 2.0 **Cumulative** GPA to remain in Good Standing
- ▶ Students should maintain a 2.0 **Term** GPA to avoid suspension
