-Submit **BOTH** a copy of your child's birth certificate **AND** Legal Dependents (LEGDP) form
- I have dependents (other than my children or spouse) who, as of the day I filed my FAFSA, lived with me and received more than half of their support from me now and through June 30, 2027.  
-Submit Dependency Status (DEPS) form
- When I was age 13 or older my parents were deceased, I was in foster care, or I was a dependent or ward of the court.  
-Submit copies of death certificates, foster care documents, or court documentation for dependent or ward of the court
- I am or was a legally emancipated minor, as determined by a court in their state of residence.  
-Submit official court documentation
- I am or was in a legal guardianship with someone other than their parent or stepparent, as determined by a court in their state of residence.  
-Submit official court documentation
- At any time on or after July 1, 2025, my high school or school district homeless liaison determined that I was an unaccompanied youth who was homeless or self-supporting and at risk of being homeless.  
-Submit documentation from the school district
- At any time on or after July 1, 2025, the director of an emergency shelter or transitional housing program funded by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development determined that I was an unaccompanied youth who was homeless or self-supporting and at risk of being homeless.  
-Submit documentation from the Department of HUD

-Submit documentation from the center/transitional living program
