## **ORP Pre-Award Checklist for completion**

If either of the first three statements are true the application is to be returned as ineligible to apply with an explanation. If any of the remaining statements are true the application is to be returned with an explanation and given 24 hours to resubmit.

1st ORP PreAward Compliance Check

- 1. Applicant is not a tenure-track faculty member at the Asst Prof. level
- 2. Applicant has previously received the Vaughnie Lindsay Award.
- 3. All previous Internal Award requirements have not been met.
- 4. Application Packet is not scanned in in the correct order as indicated on the KB form.
- 5. Project Summary exceeds 1 page/100 words

- 6. Narrative exceeds 10 pages (excludes References, Vitae and Appendices)
- 7. Pages are not numbered
- 8. Format is not compliant (e.g. 1" margins, 11-point Times New Roman or 10-point Arial font)
- 9. References or CV are not included
- 10. CV exceeds 2 pages

If application reaches this stage and both Chair and Dean letters are not attached an email is sent to the missing letter's author with a cc to the applicant that if the letter is not received within 24 hours then the application will be removed from the competition. Communication needs to indicate that the letter is to be submitted to siueresearch@siue.edu
