

Kuali Proposal Types

TYPE	DEFINITION
Awarded Contract	Typically an industry contract received without requiring a formal proposal
Budget SOW Update	Awarded contract with budget and scope of work change
Continuation	Used by Grants.gov for awarded proposals in subsequent project years (e.g. HRSA)/only S2S proposals
Funds to Faculty/Dept.	New proposals in which the sponsor requires that the funds be given directly to the faculty member or program rather than SIUE and that will not subsequently be handed over to SIUE to be managed.
Internal	Not currently used
Internship Agreement	Any standard internship agreement with an external sponsor (e.g. industry, non-profit, etc.)
New	A proposal being submitted to a sponsor for the first time
New – Changed/Corrected	Used by ORP when a correction is needed on a proposal being submitted to a sponsor for the first time/required by Grants.gov and in S2S submissions.
New In-Kind	A proposal in which the sponsor provides services or time rather than direct funding (e.g., time to use a computer server)
Pre Proposal/ Letter of Intent	A pre-proposal or letter of intent that is similar to a pre-proposal that is required by the sponsor to determine who to invite to submit a full proposal
Renewal	A proposal being submitted to renew funding (non-competitive)
Renewal – Changed/Corrected	Used by ORP when a correction is needed
Resubmission	A proposal being submitted to a sponsor after initial rejection. Proposal is to be copied and linked to original.
Resubmission – Changed/Corrected	Used by ORP when a correction is needed
Revision/Supplement	Used when an award is received in which the budget and/or scope of work needs to be modified from what was proposed and when supplemental (extra) funding is
Revision/Supplement – Changed/Corrected	Used by ORP when a correction is needed to a revised proposal or supplement. Use this when errors occur in S2S
Transfer	A proposal type used when a new faculty member transfers an existing award from their previous institution to SIUE.
These designations are related to S2S submissions.
