

Accessing Research Enabled

1. Go to <https://www.researchenabled.org/Authenticate/?ReturnUrl=/>
2. From the University dropdown menu, select **SIUE (Edwardsville)**

3. Research Enabled will then 1) log you in automatically to the system or 2) take you to the SIUE Single Sign-On page to log in with your SIUE credentials. Note: your log-in information is safe and stays only on SIUE servers.

 - a. If this is your first time accessing the system, Research Enabled will take you to your profile to complete. Include details that you think may be useful for potential university and industry collaborators and click Update Profile at the bottom of the screen to save.
