
Comparison of Illinois Basic Skills test results and ACT scores

1. This is a limited sample:


- a. Just those who took the BST Sept-Dec, 2010 (N= 5,310), and

2. I'm just the messenger.


a. Analysis is intended to be descriptive, not prescriptive





Summary of initial BST results: Number of subtests passed













Do BST scores improve on subsequent attempts?






Average Change = +28.3

% passing on 2nd attempt = 82.9%




The relationship between BST results & ACT scores

Distribution of ACT composite scores for our sample






Distribution of BST results by ACT composite score





Proportion passing BST by ACT composite score





Comparison of ACT composite scores for selected groups






Proportion passing each BST subtest by ACT college readiness status





Average number of BST subtests passed by ACT college readiness status










ACT English by BST Language Arts






ACT Math by BST Math
