***THIRD ANNUAL NURSING LEADERSHIP ACADEMY***  
***March 24-end of May, 2014***

***The goal of this program is to:***

*Expand the leadership skills of nurses in managerial/administrative positions to improve leadership effectiveness.*

***Southern Illinois University Edwardsville School of Nursing (OH-348, 6/1/2016) is an approved provider of continuing nursing education by the Ohio Nurses Association (OBN-001-91), an accredited approver by the American Nurses Credentialing Center's Commission on Accreditation.***

**This is a hybrid continuing nursing education program that includes an initial half day (8:00 AM till noon), face to face session, ten weeks of online work, and a final face to face session at the close of the offering (afternoon session, date TBA). Participants will use the Blackboard online learning platform.**

**Those who successfully complete all the learning activities, including the project proposal, all self-evaluations, and offering evaluations will be awarded a minimum of 50 contact hours. The final award of contact hours will be calculated to include time spent developing the business proposal. Continuing education evaluations for the offering will be conducted via online surveys.**

**Objectives:**

- Appraise how the role of the nurse leader influences change in health care.
- Defend the value of systems thinking in the role of the nurse leader.
- Analyze communication strategies for their impact on leadership style.
- Evaluate management decisions for their potential consequences.
- Evaluate how personal values influence management decisions.
- Assess the influence of human diversity in the management of the health care environment.
- Analyze personnel decisions such as hiring, termination, and counseling for their impact on the work environment.
- Appraise relevant evidence, including research, in the development of performance improvement processes.
- Develop an evidence-based business proposal specific to the employing organization's nursing strategic plan.

**The program faculty is Sheri Compton-McBride, MS, RN, an experienced nurse manager and School of Nursing faculty member.**

***Registration is limited to the first 20 registrants. Please register by February 24, 2014. The SIUE School of Nursing reserves the right to cancel this offering because of low enrollment. Full refunds will be provided if the offering is canceled for low enrollment.***

**Students will meet on March 24 on the SIUE campus for orientation; if there is sufficient enrollment in southern Illinois, a second cohort will meet in the Carbondale area on March 25 for orientation.**

**Fees: \$450 registration fee, which is less than \$10 per contact hour of CE credit**

**Fees must be paid by February 24, 2014**; full refund of fees if canceled by February 24, 2013. For cancellations after February 24 through March 7 a \$150 penalty will be charged and \$300 will be refunded; cancellations after March 7 a \$250 penalty will be charged with \$200 refunded.
