Basic Criteria—All applications will be evaluated based on:

- A SON student in good academic standing
- A student's goals for the nursing profession
- Community service and extra curricular activities
- Current enrollment in the School of Nursing

Awardees will be notified by SIUE e-mail or telephone by Friday, March 2, 2012.

All awards will be applied to a student's university charges in Fall 2012, for Fall 2012. (If Spring 2012 is an awardee's final semester, an award check will be processed through the Student Financial Aid Office as soon as possible.)

Scholarship and award recipients are required to attend the Scholarships and Awards Luncheon on **Thursday, April 12, 2012**, from 11:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. at the Morris University Center in the Maple Dogwood Rooms.

SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE TO UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS ONLY:

Ann Heiden Wharton Memorial Nursing Award \$200*
To support a traditional four-year student.
Applicants must be:

- Currently a junior student
- A member of the Student Nurse's Association
- Involved in community service
- Must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 or higher

Anthony Oliver and Felissa Lashley Award in Nursing \$200*
To recognize non-traditional students who demonstrate the mission of the School of Nursing and the core values of SIUE.
Applicants must:

- Currently be:
a semester 7 or 8 BS student, a junior or senior RN-BS student or an ABS student
- Must have a minimum GPA of 3.5 or higher

Cecil Howard Griffin and Florence Bowmaster Griffin Award \$500*
To honor the lives of Howard & Florence Griffin by providing scholarships for undergraduate or accelerated bachelor's degree students in the School of Nursing.
Applicants must:

- Must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 or higher

Gloria Perry RN-BSN Student Achievement Award \$1,000*

- Intend to pursue a Master's degree in Nursing

SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE TO BOTH UNDERGRADUATE & GRADUATE STUDENTS:

C. Harold Goddard Scholarship for Nursing \$1,000*
To support a BS, RN-BS, ABS or MS student from Franklin County, Illinois.

Applicants must:

- Be from Franklin County, Illinois.

Nursing Alumni Heritage Award Scholarship 4 at \$1,000*
To provide scholarships for students in the School of Nursing.

Applicants must:

- Have a minimum GPA of 3.5
- Demonstrate financial need (requires FAFSA)
- Write a one-page, double-spaced, 10 pt. font essay on the topic "The Importance of Political Activity by Student Nurses"

Other Criteria:

- BS Student—junior or senior
- ABS Student—be currently enrolled
- RN-BS Student—currently enrolled and have been enrolled for at least 2 semesters
- MS Student—currently enrolled and have been enrolled for at least one semester.

Pearl Morgan Award in Pediatric Nursing \$200*
To recognize the achievements of nursing students with a specialization or interest in pediatric nursing.

Applicants must:

- Be a BS Student—currently a junior or senior level who intends to work in pediatrics
- Be an ABS Student—currently enrolled and intends to work in pediatrics
- Be an RN-BS or MS—currently enrolled and completed at least one semester, who intends to work in pediatrics

School of Nursing Faculty Scholarship Award \$500*

- Open to any currently enrolled School of Nursing student in good standing.

Shirley Strohmeyer Memorial Nursing Award \$200*
To recognize a student best demonstrating the mission of the School of Nursing and the core values of SIUE.

Applicants must:

- Be a BS Student—currently a second semester sophomore, junior or senior nursing student
- Be an ABS Student—currently enrolled
- Be an RN-BS or MS— currently enrolled and completed at least one semester

SCHOLARSHIP AVAILABLE TO GRADUATE STUDENTS ONLY:

Dr. Jacquelyn M. Clement Scholarship in Nursing

\$3,000*

The recipient of the award will be a graduate student in the School of Nursing who:

- Will be completing the Nurse Anesthesia or Family Nurse Practitioner program within the next 12 months.
- Maintains a minimum GPA of 3.4
- Demonstrates financial need (those sponsored by a healthcare agency are not eligible)
- Exemplifies untiring caring, empathy, compassion and integrity as a professional nurse, in pursuit of graduate education and as an integral part of personal core values

Applicant must:

- Complete an essay (2 page maximum, 10 point font, double-spaced) that expresses in your own words the way you personify an outstanding dedication to the profession of nursing through caring, empathy, compassion and integrity. From this essay, it will be evident to the readers that caring is the center of your nursing practice.
- Submit a list of three (3) SIUE faculty members who can serve as a reference for your scholarship application.
- Interview with the donor, if required. (Notification of interview will be sent in February.)

Perry Graduate Excellence Award in Nursing

\$1,000*

To provide scholarship support to a graduate student in the School of Nursing.

Applicants must:

- Be nearing completion of their chosen specialization
- Have clearly demonstrated research and writing skills in their chosen specialty in an outstanding manner.

UI Springfield Nursing Award

\$500*

To support graduate students enrolled in the School of Nursing program at the Springfield site.

Applicants must:

- Be enrolled in a minimum of 6 semester credit hours
- Have completed at least 12 semester hours of the Nursing core curriculum as of the end of most recent fall term
- Have a cumulative GPA of at least 3.5
