III. Old Business: Continued Review of Honors Reform

The Council continued its review of the honors reform document. It affirmed its commitment to linking Honors 120 and Honors 121, requiring in other faculty who teach the paired courses to coordinate their syllabi and requiring incoming honors students to take pairs of the courses. The Director talked with the Registrar and confirmed that such a linkage is possible.

There was a question about whether existing systems could track course completed with the H-Contract. The director will discuss this question with the Registrar.

The Council discussed procedures for voting on the reform proposal: the council is in favor of a single vote on the whole of the document and not thirteen (13) separate votes; the council also supports the Director's inclination to allow for electronic, proxy votes to be cast.
