Dr. Santos is an Epidemiology Program Manager at the Pima County Health Department in Tucson AZ where she oversees a team of epidemiologists centered around One Health.

Her team investigates cases of vector-borne and zoonotic diseases (i.e. West Nile Virus, Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza H5N1), conducts surveillance of environmental health conditions (heat-related illness and mortality, Valley Fever, lead screening), and directs deep dives to understand social determinants of health.

Dr. Santos also leads the County's "One Health Clinic" called Healthy Companions - a mobile clinic targeting the unhoused and unstably housed population to provide integrated veterinary and human health services at the same time.
