SIUE Transfer Equivalency Self-Service

Overview

Transfer Equivalency Self-Service is a tool that helps current and prospective students understand how previous academic work may apply to their intended SIUE degree. It connects with SIUE's Degree Works audit system to generate a preliminary degree audit based on your transfer credits.

Getting Started


Accessing the Tool

Start from the Transfer Equivalency Self-Service landing page.

Account Creation (Optional)

You do not need to create an account to use the tool. However, an account allows you to:

- Save your audit
- Return to edit it later without re-entering information



To create an account, you will need:

- Email address
- Name
- Password

Note: This account is specific to Transfer Equivalency Self-Service and is not tied to your SIUE e-ID or other systems.

Step 1: Enter Your Goal Information

Regardless of whether you create an account, you will begin by entering:


- Planned enrollment term (e.g., Fall 2025)
- Program you plan to pursue
- Level (Undergraduate or Graduate this is auto-filled based on your degree)
- **Degree** you plan to pursue
- Major (based on your degree selection)

Optional:

- Minor
- Concentration

The "Your Answers" panel helps track your progress.


If you need to restart, click the circular arrow icon in the upper right.




Step 2: Enter Your Transfer Courses

Add a Class

- 1. Click "Class" to begin.
- 2. Select the **school** you are transferring from.
 - Use the search bar to filter the list.
 - If your school is not listed, you may still receive credit. The Transfer Center will review your transcripts during the formal evaluation.
- 3. Select the **course** from the list of equivalencies.
 - o If the course is not listed, it may still be eligible for credit upon official review.
- 4. Enter course details:
 - o Term taken
 - Credit hours
 - Grade received
 - Credit system (Semester or Quarter; choose "Semester" if unsure)
- 5. To add more courses from the same school, check "Add another class from this school."





Step 3: Enter Credit by Exam or Military Credit

To enter non-course credit (e.g., AP, CLEP, Military):

- 1. Select the appropriate **school** option:
 - o "Advanced Placement"
 - o "Military"
 - o Other test sources
- 2. Choose your test/course:
 - Example: AP 007.4 = AP US History with a score of 4
- 3. On the Class Information screen:
 - o Select the **term**
 - o Enter placeholder values for:

Credits: 3Grade: A

Credit Type: Semester

Required fields cannot be blank, even for test-based credit.

Step 4: View and Edit Your Degree Audit

As you enter coursework, it appears in a panel on the right.

Editing or Deleting Entries

- Click the **pencil icon** to edit
- Select the checkbox and click the minus icon to delete

Viewing Your Audit

Click:


- "Results" in the top navigation
- Or "I'm done!" to view the full audit

The audit includes:

- Program summary with progress bars
- Breakdown of requirements:
 - o General Education
 - o Intellectual Area
 - Major
 - o Minor and Concentration (if applicable)
- Summary of how each course transfers

Audit Symbols

- Green Check = Requirement fulfilled
- X Red Box = Requirement not yet met
- TRF XXX / SPAN 2XX = General elective or non-specific course



Step 5: Save or Share Your Audit

- If you did **not** create an account:
 - → Click **"Download PDF"** to save your audit for future reference.
- You can return to update or modify your data and re-run the audit at any time.

Important Notes

- This is not an official transcript evaluation.
- Official credit is awarded only after the Transfer Center reviews your transcripts.
- Use this tool as a planning resource to guide discussions with your advisor or Transfer Center staff.
