## How to Apply for an Exception to the Withdrawal and/or Refund Policies:

- 1. Appeals due to serious injury, chronic illness, mental health condition, or a medical issue that prevents attendance or completion of coursework will be reviewed by the Dean of Students Office in Student Affairs. Visit <a href="www.siue.edu/student-affairs/dean-of-students/">www.siue.edu/student-affairs/dean-of-students/</a> and complete the required medical leave of absence section located under the Student Care & Advocacy menu.
- 2. **Appeals due to death of immediate family member**: complete the Request for Exception Withdrawal and Refund Appeal Form, provide a typed statement including your name and ID number indicating your relationship to the deceased, and include an obituary. Include the desired outcome of your appeal. Submitted documentation must show the date of death and family relationship. Immediate family member is defined as parent, grandparent, spouse/domestic or civil union partner, sibling, or child. The deadline to submit an appeal to the University that is related to the death of an immediate family member is one calendar year from the end of the semester in question.
- 3. Appeals due to significant cost of living increase or a sudden or consistent lack of transportation: if you experience a significant financial hardship or a consistent lack of transportation, you should first consult with the Offices of the Bursar and Student Financial Aid prior to withdrawing to explore potential resources that would support your continued enrollment/term completion. If it becomes necessary to completely withdraw from the University as a result of the hardship, you can request consideration of a credit of tuition/fees charges. Complete the Request for Exception Withdrawal and Refund Appeal Form, provide a typed statement including your name and ID number that indicates your circumstances and how your hardship has affected your capability of completing the term, and provide supporting documentation. You must be completely withdrawn from the semester prior to filing a request for a reduction in the assessment of tuition and fees. If it is determined by the committee that your hardship impeded your ability to continue, a portion of the tuition and fees may be credited as appropriate to minimize student debt. The deadline to appeal charges is the last day of the term in which the hardship and withdrawal occurred.
- 4. **Appeals due to active military duty:** complete the Request for Exception Withdrawal and Refund Appeal Form, provide a typed statement of your desired outcome of the appeal including your name and ID number, and provide a copy of active duty military orders.
- 5. Return the completed Withdrawal and Refund Appeal Form, typed personal statement, and supporting documentation to: SIUE, Service 1080, Edwardsville IL 62026. Appeals can also be faxed to 618-650-2081, emailed to servicecenter@siue.edu, or dropped off in Rendleman Hall room 1309.

## **Additional Information:**

- Filing an appeal does not relieve your current obligation to SIUE. You are responsible for all charges assessed on your account pending a decision on your appeal.
- If your appeal is approved, it may affect your financial aid. Contact a Financial Aid representative at 618-650-3880 to determine the impact of your appeal on your financial aid.
- Veteran and military personnel receiving educational benefits may receive a fiscal consequence to their aid for pursuing a backdated withdrawal. Contact the Veterans Services at 618-650-3169.
- Courses will not be expunged from the transcript. Courses will remain on the transcript, and must reflect a withdrawal grade (W or WR) to be eligible for a credit of tuition and fees. Instructors of courses that were graded with a letter grade (A, B, C, D, F, WF, UW, I, S, DE, P, or NC) will be contacted to obtain approval for a grade change. If the instructor approves of a grade change from the assigned grade to a withdrawal grade, the appeal will then be considered for a credit of tuition and fees. Instructors reserve the right to deny grade change. If a grade change is denied by the faculty, tuition and fees will not be credited.
- Appeals are granted on a one-time basis. Multiple appeals for the same circumstances will not be considered. If an appeal is
  approved, future requests for extensions of registration, withdrawal, or refund deadlines will not be approved, absent significant
  exceptional circumstances.
- The deadline to submit an appeal for death in the immediate family is one academic year from the end of the semester in question. The deadline to submit an appeal for financial or transportation hardship is the last day of the term in which the withdrawal and hardship occurred.
- COMMITTEE DECISIONS ARE FINAL. You will be notified of the decision in approximately four to six weeks from the time of submission of all documents.

## The following issues will not be addressed through the request for exception by the Withdrawal and Refund Appeals Committee:

- Disputes regarding grades assigned by faculty.
- Complaints about class instruction or curriculum. Contact the relevant academic department.
- Request for exception to registration deadlines and/or tuition credit on the basis of job obligation.
- Requests for backdated or late withdrawal based on non-attendance. Non-attendance is not a justifiable reason for an exception to the registration deadlines and/or tuition policy. It is the responsibility of the student to maintain registration and drop classes accordingly. Deadlines are published on the Registrar's website at siue.edu/registrar.
