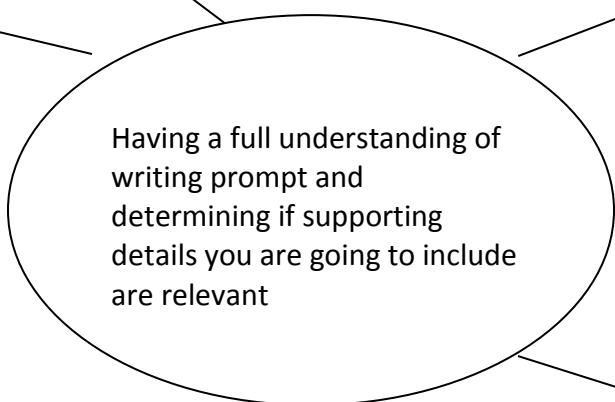

1. Read extended response writing prompt

2. Reread prompt and begin brainstorming details to support your position

3. Ask yourself if each of brainstormed support ideas and answer specifically "Are these details relevant?"

4. If not, discard and begin brainstorming

**DISCUSSION:** Relationship -1) Lesson to Unit AND 2) Importance of Lesson to Daily Life

1. Having relevant supporting details is part of a thorough extended written response

2) Dissecting instructions & fully understanding is first step in problem solving

Self- Test Questions (Evaluation):

1. Did I read the extended response writing prompt?
2. Have I reread the prompt and begun brainstorming?
3. Did I ask myself "Are these details relevant?"
4. If not, have I discarded and begun brainstorming again?
