An Example: ADEI Leadership Certificate

Outcomes, students will:

- Understand the role of inclusive excellence in organizational structures
- Communicate effectively cross-culturally
- Learn diverse leadership and communication styles
- Understand how to engage in difficult conversations effectively
- Learn how to be effective leaders, allies and advocates
- Build mutually beneficial and respectful relationships

Context:

- Successful completion of the certificate requires 40 total hours of interdisciplinary engagement and professional development, determined by personal interest
- Students can access anytime throughout college career with flexible pace







Maintenance Requests

- University Housing has a dedicated maintenance team focused on you!
- Request are submitted online while on campus WiFi
- Raise/lower/bunk bed, fix leaking sink, change light bulb, etc.
- 91% are completed with 48 hours of being submitted
- 94% of work order requests are completed within 3 business days
