Links to sources and information on commonly-taught topics at the *Teacher Resources Page*:

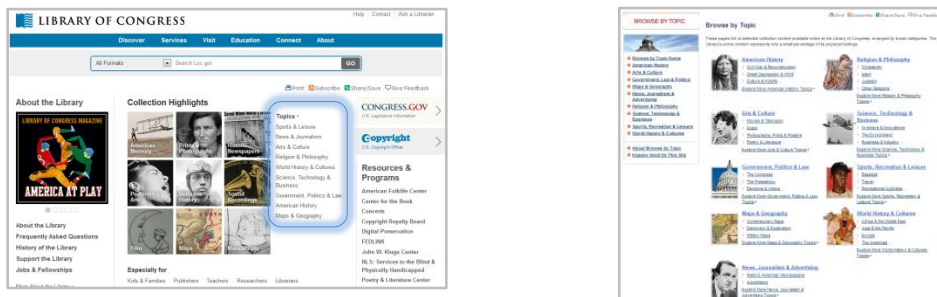
LOC.gov → Roll over the “Education” tab and click on “Teacher Resources” → Classroom Materials → **Themed Resources**

Links to sources about a particular date in American history:

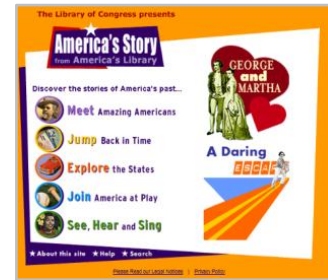
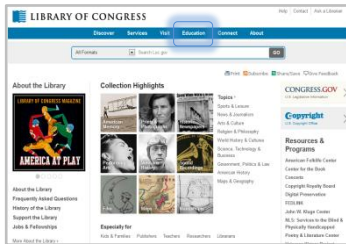
LOC.gov → scroll down to **Today in History** → “archive” → enter a search term and/or a date

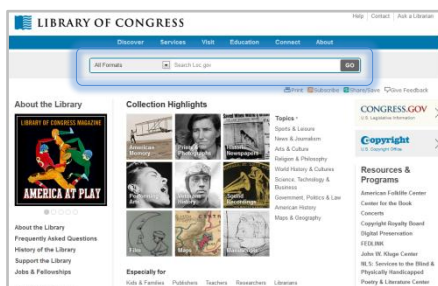

## Broadest way to search a topic:

LOC.gov → Enter a search term related to a topic (names, places, objects, or events) → Choose a format if desired → Click "GO"
