
Searching LOC.gov: Using the Global Search Box




At LOC.gov you can access online collections that include such items as maps, photographs, paintings, images of artifacts, letters, diaries, newspapers, personal accounts of events, sheet music, sound recordings, and historic films.

For a broad search across LOC.gov, type a keyword in the global search box. Further refine by choosing a "Format"

The search results list will link to various types of resources related to your keyword, like an exhibit, photograph, teacher resource page, catalog records that link to sources, presentations, webcasts, etc.



Example results page




TIP: When refining results, be sure to check "Available Online" under Access Condition.

What is an bibliographic/item record?

An bibliographic/item record is comparable to a traditional library catalog card. A record includes a title, the name(s) of the author(s) or other creator(s), and subject terms assigned by a cataloger or subject expert. They may also include other descriptive notes or information.




