STUDENTS MUST BE ACCEPTED TO SIUE PRIOR TO ADMISSION INTO THE PROGRAM.

The 2-year Partnership Program between SIUE and surrounding school districts begins each fall of the student's junior year.

EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION APPLICATION DEADLINE: February 1

February 1 Students seeking admission for the following fall term. Applications will be available on our website in September.

Check with your SEHHB Student Services advisor to verify that we have all of your updated coursework. Please note: applying to the university and to the School of Education programs are separate application processes.

All eligibility requirements are per the state of Illinois and must be met by the end of the summer semester prior to entering the program. Courses require a grade of "C" or higher. All copies of unofficial transcripts and test scores must be received by May 31(including spring and/or summer semester) before fall admission to the Partnership Program. Students are notified of their eligibility in mid-June.

PROGRAM ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS for students who receive an Associate in Arts, Associate in Science:

PSYC 233 - "C" grade or higher required

*EDUC 231/EDUC 235. Students can take EDUC 233 at LCCC or CIED 310 at SIUE during the summer prior to entering the Partnership Program. - "C" grade or higher required

Completion of all declaration requirements

Grade of "C" or higher in all Skills/Foundations courses

Fewer than 5 non-partnership program classes remaining

A cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher (including all post-secondary institutions attended) and good academic standing at SIUE.

Courses require a grade of "C" or higher. All copies of unofficial transcripts and test scores must be received by May 31(including spring and/or summer semester) before fall admission to the Partnership Program. Students are notified of their eligibility in mid-June.

STUDENTS MUST BE ACCEPTED TO SIUE PRIOR TO ADMISSION INTO THE PROGRAM.

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Additional program requirements (can be taken prior to or after acceptance into the program):

For students who receive the associate's degree: Any two college level MATH courses

For students who don't receive the associate's degree: MATH 142 and MATH 152 - "C" grade or higher required

Specific social science courses (cultural geography, U.S. history, economics or political science)- "C" grade or higher required

Specific general science courses (life science, physical science, earth/space science) - "C" grade or higher required
