STUDENTS MUST BE ACCEPTED TO SIUE PRIOR TO ADMISSION INTO THE PROGRAM.

The 2 year Partnership Program between SIUE and surrounding school districts begins each fall of the student's junior year.

ELEMENTARY EDUCATION APPLICATION DEADLINE

March 1: Students seeking admission for the following fall term. Applications will be available on our website the first Monday in January. <http://www.siu.edu/education/advisement/index.shtml>. Check with your SEHNB Student Services advisor in January to verify that we have all of your updated coursework. Please note: applying to the university and to the School of Education programs are separate application processes.

ADDITIONAL ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS/INFORMATION

All eligibility requirements are per the state of Illinois and must be met prior to entering the program. Courses require a grade of "C" or higher. All copies of unofficial transcripts and test scores must be received by May 31 (including spring and/or summer semester) before fall admission to the Partnership Program.

Additional program requirements (can be taken prior to or after acceptance into the program):

Specific social science courses (cultural geography, U.S. history, economics or political science)- "C" grade or higher required

Specific general science courses (life science, physical science, earth/space science) - "C" grade or higher required
