#### **Elementary Education Admission Requirements:**

- \*The program eligibility requirements are as follows: Completion of all skills/foundations courses (or approved equivalents) with a grade of C or better.
- \*Application deadline for admission for Fall term is February 1. Applications are available after Labor Day.
- \*Combined GPA (all post-secondary work) of 2.5 or higher.
- \*Good academic standing at SIUE (if applicable).
- \*Completion of 42 semester hours or more of college level course work.
- \*No more than 5 non-partnership program classes remaining at the end of summer term prior fall program admission.
- \*All copies of unofficial transcripts and test scores including Spring and/or Summer 2024 grades must be received by May 31, 2024.
- \*Submit this application by the due date even if eligibility requirements will not be completed until the end of Summer 2024.
