The 2- year Partnership Program between SIUE and surrounding school districts begins each fall of the student's junior year.

**SPECIAL EDUCATION APPLICATION DEADLINE**

**March 1:** Students seeking admission for the following fall term. Application is available the first Monday in January. APPLICATIONS FOR ALL PROGRAMS ARE DUE BY MARCH 1ST OF THE SEMESTER BEFORE THE DESIRED START SEMESTER. Applications will be available on our website:

Check with your SEHHB Student Services advisor in January to verify that we have all of your updated coursework. Please note: applying to the university and to the School of Education programs are separate application processes.

**ADDITIONAL ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS/INFORMATION**

All eligibility requirements are per the state of Illinois and must be met prior to entering the program. Courses require a grade of "C" or higher, with the exception of EDUC 232, which requires a "B" or higher. . . All copies of unofficial transcripts and test scores must be received by May 31(including spring and/or summer semester) before fall admission to the Partnership Program. Students are notified of their eligibility by early April.

**PROGRAM ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS for students who receive an Associate in Arts, Associate in Science:**

EDUC 232

A cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher (including all post-secondary institutions attended) and good academic standing at SIUE

Completion of all declaration requirements

Grade of "C" or higher in all Skills/Foundations courses

Completion of 42 semester hours

Completed all general education courses with a "C" grades or higher required
