Completion of an Associate in Arts or Science degree at Lincoln Land Community College fulfills SIUE’s general education requirements with the exception of an Interdisciplinary Studies course that all students must take during their junior or senior year at SIUE.

This “Transfer Program Guide” is an *example* of proposed curriculum for students to use while completing their associate’s degree. Reading, writing, and math placement could alter the course sequencing and transfer date. Therefore, students should begin sequencing their reading/writing (if applicable) and math & science courses during the first semester, paying particular attention to prerequisites. Students have the option of taking summer classes to lessen fall and spring course loads.

It is highly recommended that students meet with a Lincoln Land College advisor. Please see “**Important Student Notes**” located on page two of this transfer guide.

Students interested in pursuing the Bachelor of Arts degree option may consider using their foreign language credits as electives.

Students have 2 options when pursuing a Bachelor's degree in Anthropology.

- A Bachelor of Arts degree will require 2 semesters of the same foreign language, which can be taken at either LLCC or SIUE, in addition to 8 Humanities and/or Fine Arts Courses (some of which will be completed with the Associate in Arts.)
- A Bachelor of Science degree will require completion of 8 courses in life, physical, or social science, in addition to 2 courses with a lab component (all of which will be met with the completion of the Associate in Arts.)
