IMPORTANT STUDENT NOTES:

Admission Requirements

Admission to a major within the special education program requires satisfactory completion of the pre-special education program described in the section below. A student handbook and application forms for admission to the major are available in the School of Education, Health and Human Behavior student services, Founders Hall, room 1110. Applications should be completed by **March 1 for the fall semester**.

Application to the program is a competitive process. Applying to the program does not guarantee admission.

In order to be admitted to a teacher education cohort in special education, students must achieve:

Admission to SIUE

A cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher from all secondary institutions attended
42 semester hours of coursework

Grades of C or higher in each course included in the 15 hours of foundations coursework

A **grade of B or higher in SPE 100** or an equivalent professional level course

Good academic standing at SIUE (if applicable)

Application for admission to the special education program and transcript of all course work completed. These should be submitted **by March 1 for fall admission**.
