Reports:

President – Worked with the other constituency heads regarding recommendations for the next UPBC chair. Dr. Minor was given a list of three people to consider for the UPBC Chair.

Faculty Development Council – Lack of the EUE, needs to come back soon. The Teaching Excellence Award Committee has been putting out calls for nominations. Their operating papers aren't reflective of what they are doing.

Curriculum Council – Keith Hecht is looking into edits needed to be made to the operating papers.
