

COLLEGE ACCESS

The Illinois State Board of Education has mandated that all high school students must take the SAT in order to qualify for graduation! As a result during the week of April 12th – Collinsville High School juniors will have the opportunity to take this assessment (for free).



Typically, our 9th & 10th graders would take the PSAT 9 & 10 in order to prepare for their actual 'true score' their junior year. The more often you study for and take the assessment the higher possibility you have of improving your scores. It is important that our students participate in the following two opportunities to increase their odds of college acceptance, and scholarship assistance.

- Thursday, April 8th UBMS will review tips, tricks & suggestions for taking the SAT.
- Saturday, April 10th Take a practice SAT test for all UBMS students.
- Monday, April 12th Juniors will take the test at school!










