Research in use of the software FIGMA: The Collaborative Interface Design Tool

FIGMA is a new web-based tool used for UI/UX design, rapid prototyping, and collaboration for digital products like websites and mobile apps. It allows teams to design, test, and build user interfaces by creating interactive prototypes, design systems, and developer-ready assets all in one place. This software has replaced Adobe XD software as industry standard. This software needs to be integrated into the graphic design curriculum; giving students some classroom experience with aspects of the software prior to graduating.

FIGMA will be integrated into the fall 2026 ART 312 Intermediate Studio in Graphic Design coursework. It will likely be used to produce demo sites and apps. FIGMA is available to educators and students for free which means there is no current cost incurred by the university, department or school.
