2012 Campaign

EDWARDSVILLE, Ill.- The United Way of Greater St. Louis is nearing the end of its 2012 campaign and is currently at the halfway mark for reaching its \$72 million goal.

Due to the rising need of United Way agencies, this year's goal is \$72 million. The Campaign, which began Sept. 4 and goes until early November, has a goal that is \$1 million more than last year.

Greg Boyce, chairman and CEO of Peabody Energy and the 2012 United Way campaign chair, stressed the importance of giving the final weeks of the fundraising campaign in order to generate resources to help people in need.

"Last year, more than 200,000 people and 2,500 businesses donated to United Way, raising more than \$71.02 million, the most ever raised, and surpassing the \$71 million goal," said Boyce. "We're currently at \$37.6 million, and I'm confident the St. Louis community will meet or exceed this year's \$72 million goal."
