ALABAMA ORGANIZATIONS EAGERLY PROTEST AGAINST HOMOSEXUAL DISCRIMINATION

The “Love Won Out” conference hosted by Focus on the Family addressing homosexuality will be attracting passionate Alabama protestors. The protestors will include Equality Alabama, Parents and Friends of Lesbians and Gays of Birmingham and Covenant Community Church.

The conference is an attempt to convince families that homosexuality can change. Many homosexual residents believe the conference plays a more harmful than helpful role in the community, and intend to gather protestors outside the Metropolitan Church of God during the event.
