Their mission was to film and chronicle life after cancer. They completed their goal and filmed more than 20 hours of footage while on the road. The footage they captured has been compiled into a full-length documentary titled, "Discovering the Beating Path."

Bartlett, a film student at Columbia College in Chicago, recruited a couple of editors to work on the film.
