

Dear Parents:

These homework checklists are designed to help your child become better organized with their homework assignments. The child should write down all assignments that are given next to the appropriate subject. The column titled HOMEWORK ASSIGNED is space designated for the teacher of the particular assignment to check to make sure the student has written down the complete assignment. The teacher should sign the paper indicating that the assignment is written correctly. The column titled HOMEWORK FINISHED is space that you the parent should sign when your child has successfully completed the assignment for that particular subject. The column titled TURNED IN is designated for the teacher's initials. The teacher should initial by the appropriate subject when the assignment is turned in. Some typical subjects are listed (e.g. science, math, etc.) with additional lines for other classes that your child attends. If your child does not have homework in a subject, it is very important that he or she always write "No Homework" and then have the teacher sign it. There is space available for the student to write down all the books he/she needs to bring home at the end of that day. This should be a nice reminder of all the books they need for the subjects that they have homework in. There is also space at the bottom of the sheet where you can write any comments or concerns that you may have. If this checklist is completed correctly, you will never have to guess whether your child is being truthful when he or she says "I Don't Have Any Homework!" Good Luck!
