## Become a part of something greater than yourself: Guide Right Service Program

**G**uide Right is a program for the educational and occupational guidance of youth, primarily inspirational and informational in character. Its reach extends to high schools and colleges alike. In the latter, giving due attention to the needs of undergraduate Brothers. Conceived in 1922 by Leon W. Stewart, and suggested at the twelfth Grand Chapter of Kappa Alpha Psi, Guide Right became the fraternity's national service program. Jesse Jerome Peters, later to become the eighth Grand Polemarch, was chairman of the committee, during the administration of W. Ellis Stewart as Grand Polemarch. That insured adoption of the Program as the Fraternity's National Service Project.

The purposes of the Guide Right Service Program are to place the training, experience, and friendly interest of successful men, at the disposal of youth needing inspiration and counsel regarding their choice of a life's career, while the community is made aware of the problems that may be encountered as these youth seek to realize lives of usefulness

Guide Right encompasses many of our youth oriented programs such as mentoring, college preparatory programs, and tutoring. However, the Flagship Initiative of the Guide Right Service Program is the Kappa Leadership Development League.

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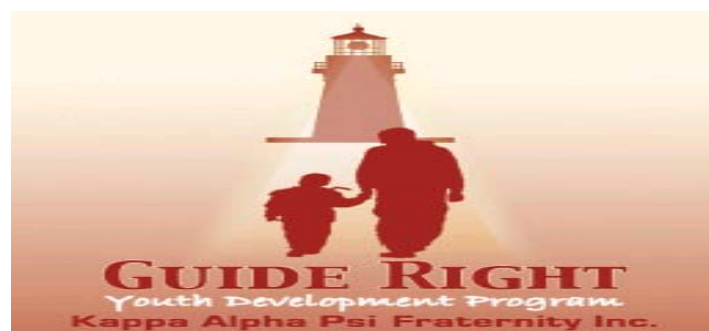
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## WHAT IS KAPPA LEAGUE?

Kappa League, formally known as the Kappa Instructional Leadership League, is the national youth initiative of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Incorporated. Kappa League focuses on training young men of color (but not exclusive to) 6th-12th grade for leadership, achievement and service in every field of human endeavor. Strong emphasis is placed upon personal development, academic achievement and college and career preparation.

NO. Kappa League is a youth LEADERSHIP organization that is focused solely on the personal development, academic achievement and college and career preparation of its young members.

Kappa League is a program for the educational, occupational and social guidance of male students in grades 6th-12th. The nucleus and primary focus of the Kappa League revolves around the “Five Phases” which are

- Self-Identity
- Discipline, Assurance, Awareness, and Appearance Training
- Academic, Career-Choice, Preparation, and Organization Competition
- Politics, Career Advancement, and Sports
- Social Religion, The Arts, Entertainment, Conversation/ Communication, and Etiquette/ Manners
- Health Education
- Physical Fitness, Sex Education, Drug Education, and Health and Safety.



## WHAT ARE THE ACTIVITIES OF KAPPA LEAGUE?

While activities will vary from chapter to chapter, almost all Kappa League chapters focus on: personal development, college preparation, community service, college field trips, career based field trips, youth leadership activities and mentoring.

## IS KAPPA LEAGUE JUST FOR AFRICAN AMERICAN MALES?

Not at all. While there is a strong focus upon African American young men, Kappa Leagues throughout the country have members that reflect the global community of young men.

## IS THE GOAL OF KAPPA LEAGUE TO HAVE ITS MEMBERS BECOME KAPPA'S?

Kappa League and Kappa Alpha Psi are two distinctly separate programs. The goal of Kappa League is to train and produce more achieving young men of color that will become leaders of impact and influence in today's society.





Kappa Kamp is conceived as a summer enrichment camp providing students, ages 12-16, with the opportunity to acquire productive life-skills through intensive workshops and learning through structured play activities. Students may choose from a number of enrichment camps and classes, as well as attend a variety of cultural and recreational activities, field trips, and educational lectures. Work, fun, and more, all take place within a safe, professionally designed and supervised setting.

The primary objectives of the enrichment camps are to:

- Provide enrichment activities for ages 12-16.
- Motivate students to seek higher levels of achievement.
- Expose students to activities rich in cultural information and experiences.
- Develop students' reading, writing, and speaking skills while involved in each camp.
- Provide experiences that focus on science technology and survival.
- Allow campers to make friends from around the world in a structured, safe environment.
- Provide a spiritual faith-based atmosphere for human growth and development.
- Provide character education and citizenship in an ethical environment.



The Achievement Academy of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc. seeks to promote development of, and to increase the representation of African American men, specifically our undergraduate fraternity members, in the nation's most selective graduate and professional schools through effective mentoring and advocacy.
